Monitoring

- Regular visits Literacy Centres are made by the team.

 Monitoring the learners' participation in the mobile based program is done by the web based system which is used to send text messages to the learners.

 Newly literates respond to multiple choice questions (MCQs) and the results of these tests are summarized and recorded in the web-based system.

 A regular monthly exams are arranged for the learners at Literacy Centres to track their retention rate and development of their literacy skill.
